Salient Features

SCCCF Chinese Studies Scholarship

Eligibility	<p>Singaporean and Singapore Permanent Resident (SPR) who are:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• 1st year full-time undergraduates who have been accepted by the UNIVERSITY to study at the DEPARTMENT and who have achieved good results in the GCE A-Levels or equivalent entrance examinations.• 2nd to 4th year full-time undergraduates enrolled in the UNIVERSITY who have achieved good academic results in their course of study at the DEPARTMENT, i.e. a minimum Cumulative Average Point (CAP) of 3.5.• Full-time undergraduates who have received the SCCC Chinese Studies Scholarship previously and who wish to be considered again. <p>The applicant should also have:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Good leadership skills & character records;• Good CCA involvement; and• Keen interest and knowledge of local Chinese businesses.

Conditions	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• The recipient shall attend an award presentation ceremony organised by the DONOR.• The recipient shall not accept any other scholarship, fellowship or award without the prior approval of the Head of the DEPARTMENT.• The recipient shall be required to write an essay of 5,000 words upon being selected to receive the SCCC Chinese Studies Sch

olarship. The topic of the essay shall be assigned by the DONOR.

- The recipient is to complete the essay within one month after being briefed on the essay topic.

SELECTION
COMMITTEE and
Procedure

- Applications may be sent to the DEPARTMENT in the month of August each year.

- The selection of the recipient of the SCCC Chinese Studies Scholarship shall be conducted in September of the same year by the SELECTION COMMITTEE.

- The SELECTION COMMITTEE shall be chaired by the Head of the DEPARTMENT or his nominee, and include one representative from the DONOR.

- The SELECTION COMMITTEE shall shortlist, interview and award the SCCC Chinese Studies Scholarship to one undergraduate who has fulfilled the relevant criteria.

- In the event that there are two or more candidates with equal merit, the SELECTION COMMITTEE shall consider the financial position and background of such candidates in deciding to whom to award the SCCC Chinese Studies Scholarship.

- The SCCC Chinese Studies Scholarship shall be formally presented to the recipient in the month of November of the same year.
