Background & Objective

The family of the late Mr Wan Boo Sow has established the Wan Boo Sow (Chinese Studies Translations) Prize.

The objective of the Medal and Prizes is to give encouragement and recognition for academic excellence and brilliance in the undergraduate body of Department.

The Awards

Four cash prizes are available and will be awarded annually based on the following criteria:

1. a) One prize, valued at \$300, will be presented to the top student who obtains the highest mark for module CL2280, Basic Translation (in Chinese/English).
 - b) One prize, valued at \$300, will be presented to the top student who obtains the highest mark for module CL2281, Translation and Interpretation (In Chinese/English).
 - c) One prize, valued at \$400, will be presented to the top student who obtains the highest mark for module CL3281, Advanced Translation.
 - d) One prize, valued at \$400, will be presented to the top student who obtains the highest mark for module CH4281, Translation Studies.
2. The prizes shall be awarded by FASS Board of Examiners on the recommendation of the Head of the Department of Chinese Studies.
 3. No award will be made unless there is a candidate of sufficient merit.
 4. This gift shall be governed by the University Statutes and Regulations, specifically, Statute 7 on Gifts to the University and the corresponding Regulation.
