

## Singapore Leong Khay Huay Kuan Scholarship

Eligibility and Other Terms	<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>a. The Scholarship is open to Singapore citizens who are of Hokkien descent (applicants to submit a copy of the Singapore Birth Certificate).</li><li>b. The Scholarship recipient must be successfully admitted to the MA by research programme (full-time) at the Department of Chinese Studies, NUS.</li></ol>
No. of Scholarship Awards	<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>a. Two scholarships will be awarded to two students.</li><li>b. Each selected candidate will be awarded \$10,000 annually, up to a period of two years, subject to the selected candidate maintaining a cumulative average point (CAP) of at least 3.5 (or equivalent) and to NUS' prevailing spending policies.</li></ol>
Application Procedure	Applications may be submitted together with the applications for admission by 15 <sup>th</sup> May of each year for the January intake or 1 <sup>st</sup> November for the August intake.
Bond Period	The Scholarship is bond-free.
Conditions	<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>a. The Department Scholarship Selection Committee, comprising the Head (Committee Chair) or his nominee and the Department Graduate Coordinator, will shortlist, interview and award the Scholarships. A member of the Donor will be invited to attend the interview of candidates.</li><li>b. No scholarship will be awarded unless there is a candidate of sufficient merit.</li></ol>
