



TENURE-TRACK POSITION IN LATE IMPERIAL CHINESE LITERATURE

The Department of Chinese Studies, National University of Singapore, invites applications with specialization in Late Imperial Chinese Literature especially in Chinese novels and/or literary criticism.

The successful and suitably qualified candidate will be appointed at the Assistant Professor/Associate Professor (tenure track) level commencing July 2018. The minimum academic qualification for the appointment is a doctoral degree with strong research training and potential. The successful candidate should possess native-speaking, or near native-speaking competence in both Chinese and English. He/she will be expected to teach both undergraduate and graduate courses (in Chinese and English), and supervise graduate students. For appointment to Associate Professor, candidates must be able to demonstrate a track record of significant publications and successful teaching. NUS is a leading university in Asia which provides rich resources and opportunities for research, competitive remuneration and generous benefits, including subsidized housing and medical coverage.

1. Covering letter and CV
2. Statements of research accomplishments and teaching philosophy/methodology

5. Three letters of reference for the post of Assistant Professor
6. Six names of referees with full contact details for Associate Professor and above.
7. Photocopies of academic transcripts and certificates
