As you may already know EDHEC's Risk and Asset Management Research Centre is N°1 in Europe for research into Risk and Asset Management. The Finance Department of the School is especially renowned for its ground-breaking research from its EDHEC Risk and Asset Management Research Centre: www.edhec-risk.com.

EDHEC's research findings are shared with students by integrating them in the MSc courses. Students therefore remain up to date with the most recent research information available in the world of finance. This gives EDHEC's Finance students a leading edge in job interviews where they can display their impressive first-hand knowledge.

The School's Finance professors are involved in applied research, consulting and executive education. A majority of them also serve as senior advisors to financial institutions or to directors in hedge funds, pension funds, regulatory bodies and non-financial corporations. Several permanent professors are regarded as international experts in the fields of asset management, fixed income securities, alternative investments and risk management and have published text books and best-sellers in these fields.

BRIEF PROGRAMME DESCRIPTION

The four programmes which make up EDHEC's portfolio of finance based MSc programmes have been designed to give participants a tailored exposure to corporate and market based financial subjects.

MSc in Finance (expected GMAT score 600)

The MSc in Finance is evenly balanced between corporate and market based finance and is a CFA Programme Partner. It is a classic advanced foundation degree programme, suitable for those who are seeking an all-round, global education into all major aspects of finance. Programme graduates typically work in corporate financial management, investment banking, commercial banking, credit analysis, corporate treasury, broking, security analysis and trading.

MSc in Corporate Finance (expected GMAT score 600)

The MSc in Corporate Finance is designed for those who want to focus exclusively on corporate finance. Graduates could expect to work in either the corporation as financial controllers, analysts or chief financial officers of a division. Alternatively the degree opens up the exciting possibility of working within investment banking, private equity, equity fund management or corporate financial services.

MSc in Risk & Asset Management (expected GMAT score 650)

The MSc in Risk & Asset Management, CFA partner programme, provides a wide-ranging coverage of market based finance and risk management concepts. Highly quantitative and best suited to those applicants with engineering or scientific backgrounds, the course is designed to meet the increasing global need for qualified quantitative analysts and risk managers for asset and liability management, hedge funds, quantitative trading teams, risk management companies and for the effective sales and marketing of exotic financial investment products. Graduates typically work in quantitative areas within the banking, hedge fund and private equity sectors.

MSc in Capital Markets (expected GMAT score 650)

The MSc in Capital Markets is specifically for those who seek to become focused experts in the theory and pricing of capital market instruments and products. Typically graduates would be employed in the capital markets division of a multinational bank as traders or market makers in equity, swaps, futures, foreign exchange, options or exotic financial instruments.

The requirements to apply to our MSc programmes are:

- 1 - To hold a Bachelor degree
- 2 - To have an acceptable score on the GMAT exam. Please visit www.mba.com for details.
- 3 - To speak fluent English, proven by an English Test as a Foreign Language (TOEFL > 100, TOEIC > 900, IELTS > 6,5). You can apply for an English Proficiency Test Waiver if you are a native-English speaker or when you can prove that you have previously studied or worked in the English language.

Our MSc programmes are one year, full time programmes taught in English on our campus in Nice. The teaching period starts in September 2009 and lasts 9 months. You will then have to complete an internship for a period of 3 months minimum (in France or in the country of your choice).

The MSc tuition fees for the academic year 2009/2010 is 13,900 Euros.

A limited number of merit-based scholarships are available. Full information about our financial assistance programme is listed on the admissions page of the MSc programme's

website. Please note that all financial aid from EDHEC Business School is reserved for applicants with excellent profiles.

The deadline to apply is 30th June 2009.
