Invitation to apply for Assistant Professor or Associate Professor: joint appointment in health studies between the Asia Research Institute and the Faculty of Arts and Social Sciences at the National University of Singapore

The Asia Research Institute (ARI) and the Faculty of Arts and Social Sciences (FASS) invite applications for a tenure-track joint appointment in Health Studies in an Asian context. The appointee would hold a research appointment in ARI, and would also teach one course per annum in a relevant department in the Faculty. Departments interested in health studies include, but are not limited to, Sociology, Economics, Geography, History and Social Work and Psychology.

ARI is already conducting research into health studies, notably through the Asian Metacentre for Population and Sustainable Development, which focuses its research, conferences and workshops on the interactions between migration and family health and wellbeing in the region. Both ARI and FASS have interests in a wide range of health issues, and would like to appoint an outstanding scholar in this field, perhaps in mid-career or a promising scholar at an earlier career stage.

As a tenure-track appointee at the level of Assistant Professor or Associate Professor, the successful candidate would be expected to build a career at the National University of Singapore, with favourable conditions for research and contact with a dynamic faculty in one of the world's highly reputed universities.

The appointee will be offered a salary commensurate with experience in the range:

Assistant Professor S\$60,000.00 to S\$144,000.00.

Associate Professor S\$108,000.00 to S\$204,000.00
