**Abstract**

Lionel Bailly will talk about his recently published book, *Lacan* (Oxford: Oneworld Publications, 2009), which introduces Jacques Lacan for beginners and seeks to demonstrate how Lacan's ideas are still relevant. Lacan's influence has been greater in critical theory (philosophy, linguistics, literary theory, English and cultural studies) than in psychiatry. His insights, however, were clinically derived, and Bailly offers a valuable account of Lacanian theory from the point of view of clinical relevance.
