

## **Behavioural Sciences Unit Research Grant**

### **Purpose**

The Behavioural Sciences Unit (BSU) based at Home Team Academy, Ministry of Home Affairs, hopes to encourage and support research projects related to forensic psychology. This includes, but is not restricted to, the following topics:

- Resilience
- Terrorism
- Forensic Psychology

Research grants are intended to support independent research conceived and carried out by students. We provide grants amounting to \$1,000 per applicant each year to support students pursuing research on issues related to forensic psychology at the Undergraduate and Honours levels. Applicants pursuing higher degrees (e.g. Masters, PhD, etc) may be considered for a higher quantum.

### **Criteria**

The project proposal must:

- Demonstrate significance and originality in the context of existing literature and research;
- Propose appropriate strategies for conducting the research based on the topic or issue selected, including a plan for systematic analysis that will produce objective and reliable results;
- Add to our current understanding of forensic psychology in the local setting;
- Show feasibility to be completed within the established time frame and budget.

### **Deadline**

Applications are open all year round. Upon receipt of application form (with all relevant documents attached), notice of approval of grant would be emailed within 3 months.

### **Procedures**

To apply, please download the Research Grant application form as attached and submit together with the following supporting documents:

- 'O' and 'A' Level certificates;
- Transcripts of University examination results;
- A recent passport photograph;
- All other documentary evidences as stipulated in the application form.
